Thank you for choosing to bring your organization to the Chilo Lock 34 Park yurts. In doing so, you are supporting your local park district and their work throughout Clermont County.

Chilo Lock 34 Park has a variety of free activities available for your visit. They include a museum, a playground and a nature preserve with over a mile of hiking trails. We welcome you to enjoy these features during your visit.

As visitors and supporters of the parks, we would like to ask for your help during your visit. Please review rental and park rules with your group before your visit begins. Please note these particular areas that may require extra diligence.

- Children MUST be accompanied and supervised by adults while touring the Chilo Lock 34 Visitor Center and Museum.
- Crooked Run State Nature Preserve is for foot traffic only. Nothing should be removed including sticks, rocks, berries, live animals, etc.
- Please use extra caution near the boat docks and boat ramp. The Ohio River currents can be dangerous. People launching boats are concentrating on their boats- NOT YOU!

If you are planning to request a Naturalist program for your group, it must be scheduled at least 60 days in advance as open spots fill quickly, especially during spring and fall. We are, unfortunately, unable to arrange programs scheduled last minute.

Before your program's scheduled start time, we request you organize your group and have them ready at the pre-designated meeting time and location.
