

**Yurt Rules & Rental Information**

Thank you for choosing Clermont Park District for your event.

Yurts are rented only to organized youth groups, for example: Scouts, Church youth groups, etc.

**Rates**

The rental rate for each of the yurts is \$75.00 each per night.

There is an additional fee if paying by credit/debit card.

**Rental Time**

The yurt is available at Noon and must be vacated at 10:00AM the following morning. Special arrangements can be made on times. Please contact the Park District Office to make arrangements.

**Amenities**

The yurt is a **non-smoking** facility. The yurts are equipped with electric stoves for heat, a ceiling fan and multiple electric outlets. The lessee is responsible for clean up of the yurt and surrounding area and for lost or stolen items. When leaving turn lights off, secure window flaps, and be sure the switch on the stove is turned off and the ceiling fan is off. Each yurt will comfortably sleep 20-25.

You might want to bring a sleeping bag, mat or cushion, flashlight, bug spray, sunscreen, water bottle, a first aid kit, ice and a cellular phone for emergency use. Restrooms with running water, picnic tables, grills, and a campfire circle with wood provided for overnight guests. Playground equipment, basketball court are available in the park. There are no showers, phones or refrigeration.

The outdoor fire ring must have adult supervision at all times. Do not burn trash in the fire ring. Do not gather wood in the park or nature preserve. Keep fire small and under control.

**Please take note of the following**

- ≡ Children must be accompanied by an adult in the visitor center/museum.
- ≡ Trash cans are available within the park, so please do not litter the outdoor areas.
- ≡ Per Ohio state law, beer and other alcoholic beverages are prohibited on public grounds.
- ≡ Fishing in the river is permitted with the proper license; all state laws must be observed.
- ≡ The collection of fees, donations, offerings, or the charging of admission is prohibited on park property.
- ≡ The lessee is liable for all damage to plants, trees, park grounds and property resulting from the contract holder's use of the park. All charges will be charged directly to the lessee. All other park rules must be observed. For a copy of park rules or for specific questions please call the main office.
- ≡ **Yurts are rented only to organized youth groups, for example: scouts, church youth groups, etc.**
- ≡ NO Fireworks of any kind ( no sparklers)

**Contract**

Reservations must be made at least two weeks in advance prior to your rental date and can be made by calling our office at 513-732-2977, or you can stop at the office at 2156 Highway 50, Batavia, OH. 45103.

**If the rental is less than 30 days, it will need to be paid by a credit card or money order only.** You can pay with credit card by phone. If paying by credit/debit card there is a convenience fee. **No cash will be accepted.**

The yurts must be reserved by an adult 18 years or older. The contract is non-transferable and must be in your possession at the time of the rental. Minors must be accompanied by an adult. The yurt is for your exclusive use; however, the surrounding grounds will remain open to the public. A sign will be posted by the park district indicating the time and date of your reservation.
